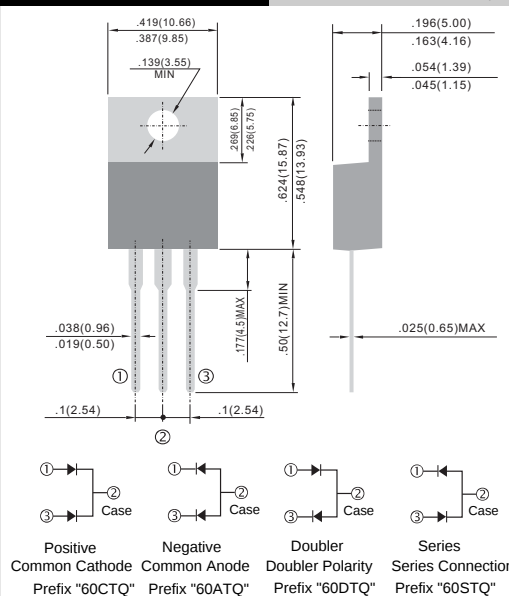

FIG. 1 MAXIMUM FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE

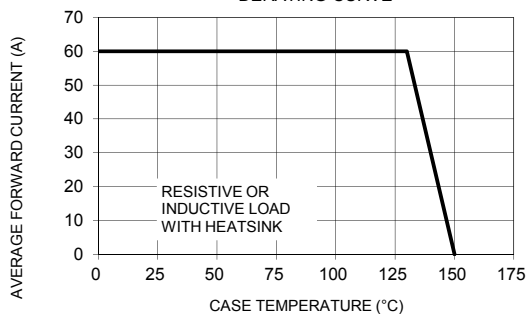


FIG. 2 MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE FORWARD SURGE CURRENT PER LEG

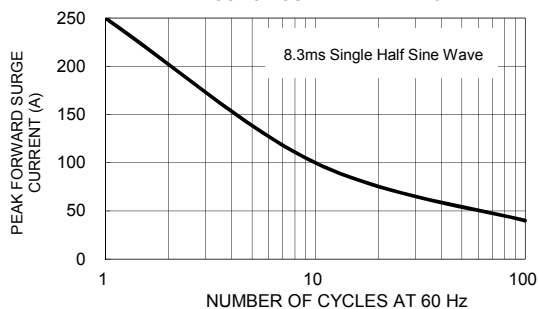


FIG. 3 TYPICAL FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS PER LEG

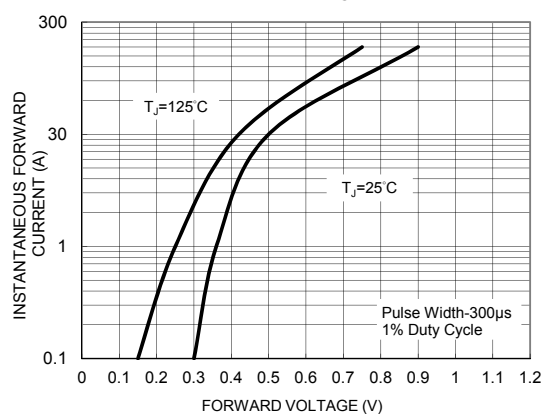


FIG. 4 TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS PER LEG

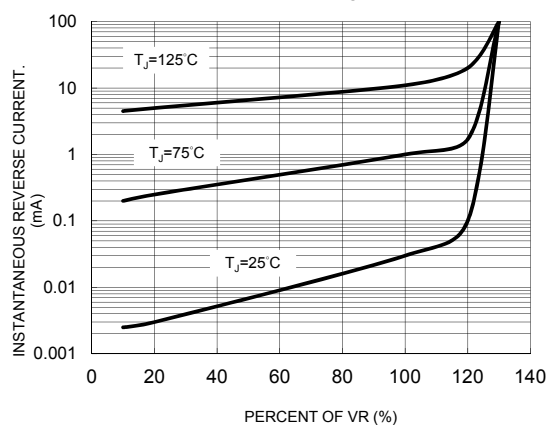


FIG. 5 TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE

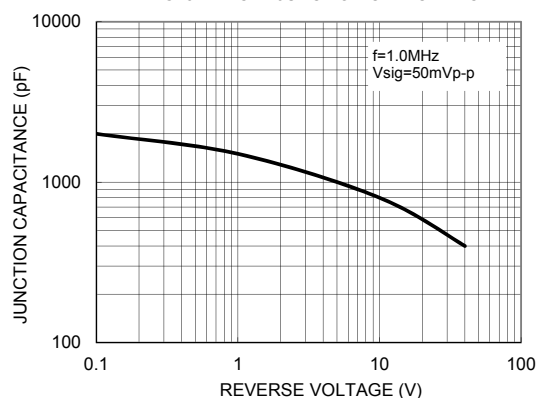


FIG. 6 TYPICAL TRANSIENT THERMAL IMPEDANCE PER LEG
